



String Me Along

Supplies:

½ inch wide strips of construction paper in six different colors
pencil
glue or tape
18-inch piece of yarn for each necklace

Directions:

1. Roll each strip of paper tightly around a pencil.
2. Glue or tape end of paper to secure.
3. Slide paper bead from pencil. When glue is set, the beads are ready to use.
4. Students should make an equal number of beads from each of the six colors of paper.
5. String beads on yarn. Ends of yarn may be secured with tape to prevent fraying. It will take approximately 18 to 24 beads to make a necklace.

Each of the six colors represents one of the basic needs of a child—physical, intellectual, social, character, trust, and love and discipline.
